GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** Rockford downed the Griffins in overtime in the teams' most recent meeting and now has points in eight of the last 13 meetings since the final contest of the 2016-17 campaign (7-4-1-0 in that span). Including each of the first two meetings of this season's series, with Grand Rapids winning at Van Andel Arena and Rockford winning at the BMO Harris Bank Center, the home team (in general wins and losses) has posted a 48-19 record since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- **USE THE FORS:** Anton Forsberg is unbeaten in four road starts this season, posting a 4-0-0 record with a 1.74 GAA and .935 save percentage in games away from the BMO Harris Bank Center. He enters Friday having limited opponents to two or fewer goals in each of his four road starts (and seven of eight games overall) this year. Dating back to his final season with Cleveland in 2016-17, Forsberg is unbeaten in regulation over his last seven road games (6-0-1).
- **POINT PARTY:** Nick Moutrey notched an assist against Grand Rapids last Friday for his first point with the IceHogs. With Moutrey's helper, 24 of 31 skaters who have appeared in a game with the IceHogs have now scored at least one point. In addition, 21 of 24 skaters on Rockford's active roster have tallied at least one point.
- **THREE FOR THE ROAD:** The IceHogs travel to Grand Rapids with points in each of their last three road games. The IceHogs have also scored the first goal in each of those last three road games, netting the opening tally against Chicago, Milwaukee and San Antonio. Rockford has a victory and two shootout losses during that road-game stretch.

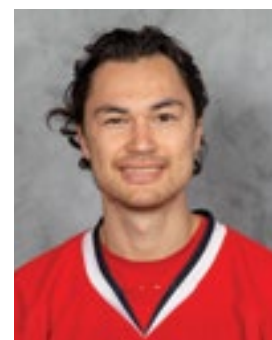
