GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs were shut out in their home opener against Milwaukee on Dec. 1 and have now dropped each of their last eight home games against the Admirals dating to March 14 of the 2016-17 season. Rockford is 0-6-1-1 at the BMO during that stretch, notching its last home win on Feb. 12, 2017 (2-1 win). The IceHogs outshot the Admirals 28-22 during the most recent meeting between the teams and have now outshot Milwaukee in three of the first four meetings this season (105-96 overall).
- **POWER OUTAGE:** Rockford and Milwaukee have each been held scoreless on the power play through four games in the 2018-19 series. The two teams have combined to kill off 34 power plays during that stretch, with the IceHogs going 18-for-18 on the PK and Admirals at 16-for-16. Rockford and Milwaukee have faced each other six times since the last contest in which both teams scored a power-play goal (March 2, 2018).
- **KILLER INSTINCT:** The IceHogs combined to kill off each of Grand Rapids' four power-play opportunities during Sunday's game at the BMO Harris Bank Center. With the effort, Rockford now boasts the AHL's best penalty kill at home with a 90.2 (46-for-51) efficiency. The team's five PPGs allowed at home are just one more than the league-low total by San Jose.
- **TONIGHT'S PROMOTION:** Tonight's contest against Milwaukee is a Fas Fuel Winning Weekday. If the IceHogs win, all fans in attendance can redeem their game ticket for a free ticket of equal or lesser value to the next weekday home game. It is also a \$2 Dog Day. For an additional \$2, fans can bring their dog to the arena to enjoy IceHogs hockey. Hot dogs will also be available from concessions for just \$2.
