BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: Rockford snapped a five-game skid to the Milwaukee Admirals with an overtime win on Nov. 2. Including that victory, the IceHogs have just five wins in the last 21 meetings dating to the 2016-17 season (5-12-2-2). The Hogs finished the 2017-18 series with an overall record of 2-6-0-2, but notched each of their two wins at the UW-Milwaukee Panther Arena. Rockford successfully killed off each of the Admirals' seven power plays in the series opener on Nov. 2 and is now 15-for-16 on the PK over the last three meetings with Milwaukee.

DOUBLE DIP: Both rookies Dylan Sikura and Jacob Nilsson posted a multi-point effort in their first career game against the Admirals on Nov. 2. Sikura logged a goal and an assist, while Nilsson picked up two helpers in the contest. Overall, three rookies scored in the game for Rockford, including Victor Ejdsell, who notched an assist in the win.

MARITIME MATHESON: Matheson Iacopelli has collected seven points (7a) in 11 career games against Milwaukee, including notching his first multi-point game of his pro career last year (April 8 at MIL). The forward finished second among all IceHogs skaters in assists against the Admirals last season with five helpers in seven contests (trailed Erik Gustafsson, 7a).

SIKURIN SHOTS: Dylan Sikura has fired multiple shots in 11 of his first 13 AHL games. He enters Friday with 13 more shots on goal than any AHL rookie thus far this season, and is ranked third overall in the AHL with 47 total shots. The next-closest rookie ranks 26th in the AHL in total SOG (Drake Batherson, BEL, 34 SOG).

BUDDY SYSTEM: Rockford is one of just two teams (also San Jose) to feature two goalies in the top 10 of qualified GAA entering Friday. Anton Forsberg ranks fifth in the league with a 1.99 GAA through his three appearances, while Collin Delia is 10th with a 2.34 GAA over eight outings. The duo has combined to allow just 25 goals on 365 shots.

CENTRAL CASTING: Rockford is playing in the fifth contest of a stretch in which it plays 39 consecutive games against an opponent from the Central Division. The IceHogs will not face an opponent outside of the Central Division until Feb. 6, when they host the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins. The Hogs have points in 14 of the last 18 games against the Central Division (11-4-1-2 record).

KILLING THEM SOFTLY: The IceHogs combined to hold the AHL's top-ranked power-play unit from Iowa to just two goals in 13 opportunities over the teams' most recent three-game series. Rockford has allowed just seven power-play goals in 58 times shorthanded, good for the AHL's fourth-best mark of an 87.9 PK efficiency. The IceHogs enter Friday as one of just five teams in the AHL to rank in the top 10 in both home PK record (92.3%) and road PK record (84.4%).
