BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have points in three straight games against the Admirals (2-0-0-1) to open the series. Following last Saturday's game, the IceHogs have dropped each of the last four shootouts against the Admirals and are just 1-7 over the last eight shootouts in the series since the 2015-16 season. Rockford enters Saturday having killed off each of Milwaukee's 15 power plays this year, and is now 23-for-24 on the PK over the teams' last six games.

MATCH PLAY: Through each of the first three games between Milwaukee and Rockford, after the first goal of the game has been scored, the opposing team has responded with the equalizing tally less than three minutes later in the same period:

SMOOTH SAILING SIKURA: Dylan Sikura fired six shots against the Admirals last Saturday, just one shy of his season-high shot total this season. Sikura has now combined for 13 shots in just three games against Milwaukee (4.3/game). He ranks second in the AHL in shots on goal, and his 13 shots against the Ads are his most against any team in the league thus far this year.

CHUCKIN' DEUCES: The IceHogs have limited opponents to two or fewer goals in half of their first 22 games this season. The Hogs enter Saturday ranked seventh in the AHL with an average of just 2.91 goals allowed per game.

THE ROAD MORE TRAVELED: The Hogs have played a league-high 14 road games this season, including capping last month with 10 of their 13 November games on the road. Rockford will now play seven of their next eight games at the BMO Harris Bank Center, where it has notched points in 30 of 46 games since the beginning of last season.

JOLT FROM JOHNSON: Luke Johnson was reassigned from the Chicago Blackhawks prior to the IceHogs' most recent game on Sunday, and netted the game-winning goal in a 3-2 win over the Wolves. He has three points in three games with the IceHogs this year and 17 points (6g, 11a) over his last 23 AHL games (including playoffs) dating to March of last year.

ROCK(ford) & A HARD PLACE: The IceHogs return to the BMO tied with WBS for the longest home winless streak in the AHL (both active and overall). The Hogs are winless over their last five home games with a record of 0-3-0-2. The skid is one game shy of matching the franchise's all-time winless streak, set during UHL affiliation in 1999-2000 and matched three times during AHL affiliation.
