BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs snapped a three-game win streak against the Griffins with a 2-1 loss in the most recent meeting. Despite the setback, Rockford boasts points in 10 of the last 15 meetings since the final game of 2016-17 (9-5-1-0). The home team has won four of five games in 2018-19, and in general wins and losses, has posted a 50-20 record in the series since 2010-11. As part of that streak, the IceHogs enter Friday with an eight-game winning streak at the BMO against the Griffins.

ELIAS SAYS...: Each of Rockford's last three games have been decided by one goal and 24 of the IceHogs' 41 total games (58.5%) this season have been settled by a lone goal. The IceHogs' 24 one-goal games are the second-most in the AHL behind only Bridgeport's 26 contests decided by one tally. Further, 15 of the Rockford's 23 road games (65.2%) have been one-goal games, and half of the 24 overall one-goal games have a final score of 2-1.

ROAD WOES: The IceHogs extended their road winless streak to a season-high seven straight games. The streak is the longest active road winless streak in the AHL, and is tied with Providence, Ontario and Belleville for the longest overall road winless streak in the league for 2018-19. Rockford is 0-5-1-1 and has been outscored 21-9 on the road in that span.

QUICK ON THE TRIGGER: Rockford suffered just its fourth loss when scoring the first goal during Tuesday's game at San Antonio. Including the loss, the IceHogs still boast points in 13 of 17 games when scoring first with an 11-4-0-2 record in such games.

LOCKED IN LANKINEN: Goaltender Kevin Lankinen has limited opponents to two or fewer goals in five of his last seven games dating to Nov. 17. The netminder is 10th in the AHL in save percentage and 12th in the league in GAA over that span with a .924 save percentage and 2.25 GAA. Lankinen has made 25+ saves in five of those games and 30+ saves in three of those contests in that time.

LATE BLOOMERS: The IceHogs have allowed just three goals in the third period over their last eight home games dating to Dec. 7. Rockford, which has been outscored 32-31 in the third period this season, has outscored opponents 9-3 in the third period over those last eight home contests.

ON THE EJD OF GLORY: Victor Ejdsell has tallied points in two of three games since returning to the lineup on Jan. 11. The forward scored his fifth goal of the season with a marker in the first period on Friday, and now has 15 points in 30 contests this season. The goal was his first since Nov. 25.

QUICK HITS: William Pelletier has points in two of his last three games...Luke Johnson has four points in his last four games with two multi-point efforts...Rockford scored a season-high six goals in its last home game.
