BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have downed the Griffins in overtime in back-to-back meetings and now have points in nine of the last 13 meetings since the final contest of the 2016-17 campaign (8-4-1-0 in that span). Rockford returns the BMO Harris Bank Center with the home team (in general wins and losses) having posted a 48-20 record in the series since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.

NOT-SO-GRAND RAPIDS: The IceHogs went unbeaten in their five home games against Grand Rapids in 2017-18, marking the most home victories in a single season against the Griffins. The IceHogs also triumphed in the first home game of this season's series and enter Sunday with wins in seven straight home games against Grand Rapids (dating to the final meeting of the 2016-17 season). Rockford has outscored the Griffins 27-14 at home in that span.

POWER UP: The IceHogs netted a power-play goal last night against Texas and now have PPGs in three of the last four games since Dec. 7. The IceHogs are 4-for-14 (28.6%) with the man-advantage in that span, including potting a pair of PPGs against the Griffins on Dec. 14.

WE'RE OVER IT: Rockford played into overtime for the fourth time in five games Saturday against Texas. The IceHogs have now also played beyond regulation in six of their last 10 games dating to Nov. 20, which is the second-most OT games in the AHL over that span behind only Iowa (7 OT in 13 games). Grand Rapids has also played into OT six times (in eight games) during that stretch, and the IceHogs and Griffins enter Sunday with a combined 12 OT games since Nov. 20.

FOUR SCORE: Anton Forsberg made a season-high 49 saves last night against the Stars. With the effort, IceHogs goaltenders have made 35+ saves in each of the last four home games. Rockford goaltenders have combined for 161 saves (172 shots) and a .936 save percentage in that span between Collin Delia (35 SVs/39 SH), Kevin Lankinen (36 SVs/38 SH) and Anton Forsberg (90 SVs/95 SH).

THE SHREDDER: Jordan Schroeder scored a goal against Texas last night and has now found the scoresheet in seven of 12 games since returning from injury on Nov. 16. Schroeder has logged two goals and six assists and leads the team in overall scoring during that stretch.

FORTIN FOR THE WIN: Alexandre Fortin notched his first point with the IceHogs this season during Saturday's game vs. Texas. Fortin finished tied for third on Rockford with 12 assists at the BMO last season, and has now scored 15 of his 22 AHL points on home ice.

ONE-AND-NOT-DONE: The IceHogs have won three of their last five games, each by a one-goal margin in 3-2 OT victories. Rockford enters Sunday having notched each of its last six wins by just one goal, dating to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee.
