BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have won three straight games against the Griffins - each by a one-goal margin - and have points in 10 of the last 14 meetings in the series since the final game of 2016-17 (9-4-1-0 in that span). With a Rockford win at the BMO Harris Bank Center in the most recent game of the series, the home team (in general wins and losses) has posted a 49-20 record since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.

VAN-ANDALIZING THE GRIFFINS: Jordan Schroeder has 11 points over his last eight games at Van Andel Arena, logging three goals and eight assists in that span. Overall, Schroeder enters Monday with 22 total points (9g, 13a) in 31 career games against the Griffins.

WE DARE SAY: Darren Raddysh paces the IceHogs in scoring with 21 points (7g, 14a) in 34 games this year. He is currently tied for fifth among AHL defenseman in goals and ninth in overall scoring from the blueline. Through his first 34 games, he has only once posted a stretch of more than two straight games without tallying a point.

SAVE THE DATE: Raddysh enters the final game of 2018 with the fourth-most points by a defenseman at the turn of the New Year in team history (AHL affiliation). His 21 points prior to Jan. 1 trail only Adam Clendening in 2013-14 (23 points), T.J. Brennan in 2014-15 (28 points) and Brian Connelly in 2011-12 (29 points). Additionally, Raddysh has already tied the team record for most goals by a defenseman before the New Year (also Cameron Schilling and Brennan). If he scores tonight, he will become Rockford's first defenseman with eight goals by Jan. 1 during AHL affiliation.

IS THAT GOAL REGULATION SIZE, OR WHAT?: The IceHogs have combined to score just three goals on 83 shots over the last three games, good for just a 3.6 shooting percentage in that span. Rockford is one of only four AHL teams shooting below 9.0 percent on the year and its overall shooting percentage of 8.3 percent ranks last in the league.

THE SCHREDDER: Jordan Schroeder logged an assist Saturday at Chicago and now has seven points (3g, 4a) over his last eight games since Dec. 14. The forward has also fired a shot on goal in 24 of 25 contests this year, including 20 games with multiple SOG, and his 2.9 shots on goal/game are nearly a full shot better than any current IceHogs skater.

LOCKED IN LANKINEN: Rookie netminder Kevin Lankinen set a franchise record (AHL) for most saves in a single period with 25 stops on 26 shots in the first period Saturday against Chicago. Lankinen surpassed Alec Richards' previous record of 21 saves set on Nov. 18, 2011 (at CHA). His 25 saves stand as the third-most by any AHL goaltender in the first period since Rockford joined the league in 2007-08 (the most in that span is Mike McKenna, 28 saves on Feb. 25, 2012 with BNG).
