BACON BITS

SCARE TACTICS: The IceHogs cap their two-game, season-opening road trip with the second of four total matchups this year against the Monsters and second of two road games in the series...Rockford dropped the series opener last night and is just 6-11-1-1 at the Quicken Loans arena since the 2012-13 season...With the loss, the IceHogs are unable to post a winning record on the road in the series this year, and have now posted a record of .500 or below against the Monsters at Quicken Loans in each of the last seven seasons.

HIGH-SCORING AFFAIR: Each of the last nine matchups between the IceHogs and Monsters have featured at least one team scoring three or more goals, including Cleveland potting four tallies in the opener last night...Of those nine games, three included both teams scoring at least three goals.

ET TU, BERUBE: Former IceHogs goaltender J.F. Berube allowed just one goal against his former Rockford club last night...Berube, who also posted a shutout in his IceHogs debut in 2017-18, has now held opponents to two or fewer goals in his season debut in each of his last four AHL campaigns...The netminder has combined for 105 saves on 109 shots in his season debuts over that four-year span.

HIGHMORE'S HIGH SCORES: IceHogs leading goal scorer from 2017-18, Matthew Highmore, potted the team's lone tally in Friday's game with a strike at 17:11 in the opening period...Highmore set Rockford's rookie goal-scoring record with 24 tallies last season and has now combined for 25 goals in just 65 games with the IceHogs...He also boasts a point-per-game average against the Monsters, entering Saturday's matchup with nine points (4g, 5a) in nine games since the beginning of last season...Highmore also boasts a four-game point streak against Cleveland dating to Jan. 19, 2018.

FIRST FOR EVERYTHING: Matthew Highmore put the Hogs on the board first with his first-period tally in Friday's contest...The IceHogs, who eventually dropped Friday's game after scoring the first goal, lost only six games in regulation during the 2017-18 season when scoring the first goal...Rockford was 23-6-0-2 in its 31 games when scoring the first goal last year.

ON THE REBOUND: The IceHogs enter Saturday seeking to avoid back-to-back losses to open the 2018-19 campaign...Rockford went 11 contests during the 2017-18 season before suffering its first set of back-to-back losses, beginning the season with a 7-2 record before dropping its 10th and 11th contests of the campaign.

HOT SHOT: The IceHogs continued their trend from 2017-18 of outshooting the opposition, firing 25 shots to Cleveland's 22 shots in Friday's contest...Including last night's game, Rockford has now outshot opponents in 55 of 73 regular-season games since Jeremy Colliton took over as head coach at the beginning of the 2017-18 season.
