BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have won just one of the last seven road games against the Rampage since the 2016-17 season, notching the lone victory on April 4, 2018 (4-2 win). Rockford has held San Antonio to two or fewer goals in three of four games this season and five of the last seven meetings dating to Feb. 7, 2018. San Antonio has outshot the Hogs in each of the four meetings this season, and boasts a 138-101 advantage in total shots in the series.

ROAD WOES: Despite notching a point with a shootout loss at Texas last night, the IceHogs remain winless over their last five road games. The streak is currently tied for the longest active road winless streak in the AHL (also Springfield). Rockford is 0-3-1-1 and has been outscored 15-5 on the road in that span.

COMIN' IN HOT: The IceHogs scored a goal in the first period against Texas last night, marking the team's first first-period tally since Dec. 28 vs. Chicago. Rockford now boasts points in 13 of 17 games when scoring at least one goal in the first period with a 10-4-0-3 record in such games.

KID SIKKI: Dylan Sikura reached double-digit goals for his rookie campaign with his 10th marker of the season last night in Texas. Sikura has three points (1g, 2a) in two games since returning from Chicago, and six points (4g, 2a) in his last five AHL games overall dating to Dec. 2. The forward has yet to go more than two straight games without registering a point through his first 28 career AHL contests.

POWERED UP: The IceHogs scored multiple power-play goals for just the fifth time this season last night at Texas. Each of those five games with multiple PPGs have been on the road, with Rockford accomplishing the feat on Oct. 19 at TUC (2 PPGs), Oct. 20 at TUC (3), Nov. 10 at CHI (2), Dec. 14 at GR (2) and Jan. 11 at TEX (2)

SHOOTOUT SHUTOUT: Rockford dropped its fifth consecutive shootout to open the 2018-19 season with Friday's loss to the Stars. IceHogs skaters are a combined 1-for-13 in shoototut, with Anthony Louis converting on the lone goal this season. The five-game losing streak in the shootout is the longest stretch in Rockford's AHL history.

SCHROEDER'S SPECIALTY: Jordan Schroeder picked up an assist on the power play last night and has now tallied more than half of his 20 total points while on the power play. Schroder has combined for 11 power-play points with four PPGs and seven PP assists, each of which leads the team.

ANT MAN & THE HOGS: With a goal at Texas, Anthony Louis enters Saturday with points in nine of his last 14 games since Dec. 14. Louis has 12 points (2g, 10a) over those 14 games, and leads Rockford in overall scoring with 25 points (10g, 15a) on the season.
