BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have won just one of the last eight road games against the Rampage since the 2016-17 season, notching the lone victory on April 4, 2018 (4-2 win). San Antonio has outshot the Hogs in each of the five meetings this season, and boasts a 177-137 advantage in total shots in the series. The IceHogs must win tonight's game to avoid going winless on the road in the series for just the third year in 12 seasons. Rockford also went winless at San Antonio in 2013-14 and 2016-17.

ROAD WOES: The IceHogs extended their road winless streak to a season-high six straight games. The streak is the longest active road winless streak in the AHL (two more than any other AHL team) and is tied for the third longest overall road winless streak thus far in the league this season. Rockford is 0-4-1-1 and has been outscored 19-8 on the road in that span.

3 FOR ME: The IceHogs have scored 3+ goals in three straight games for just the second stretch this season. Rockford scored a season-high six goals on Jan. 6 vs. Iowa before notching three goals in each of the two contests last week. The team's only other such stretch was a five-game span with 3+ goals from Oct. 13-24.

WE'RE OVER IT: The Hogs are currently tied for the most overtime games in the AHL this season following Friday's shootout in Texas. Rockford has played into overtime in 14 of 40 games to match Bridgeport, Iowa and Milwaukee for the league lead. Entering Monday, three of the four teams to have played in a league high-tying 14 OT games this season are in the Central Division.

THE SCHROEDDER: Jordan Schroeder extended his point streak to a season high-tying three straight games with points in each of the two games over the weekend, including posting just the seventh multi-goal game for a Rockford skater with his two tallies on Saturday at San Antonio. Schroeder has four points (2g, 2a) during his streak and 11 points (5g, 6a) over his last 14 games since Dec. 14. The forward also potted his 100th career AHL goal during Saturday's game against the Rampage. Schroeder has scored 100 goals between Rockford (9), Cleveland (14), Iowa (30), Chicago (33) and Manitoba (14).

KID SIKKI: Dylan Sikura has points in each of his three games since returning from the Chicago Blackhawks on Jan. 6. Sikura has combined for four points (2g, 2a) in those three contests, and has yet to go more than two straight games without registering a point through his first 29 career AHL contests.

CARL! GOOD TO SEE YOU: Lucas Carlsson also extended his own point streak to a season high-tying three straight games with an assist in both Friday and Saturday's contests. Carlsson has now found the scoresheet in seven of his last 10 games dating to Dec. 15. The defenseman leads all IceHogs blueliners in scoring over that stretch with nine points (5g, 4a) in those 10 games.
