BACON BITS

LAST GAME:

» Jordan Schroeder tallied twice and Victor Ejdsell scored the shootout game-winner as the Rockford IceHogs mounted an improbable four-goal comeback to defeat the Iowa Wild 5-4 Saturday night at the BMO Harris Bank Center.

ICEHOGS VS. WILD SERIES NOTES

- » Rockford has won each of the first two home games of the series and have points in 18 of the last 23 home games against SA.
- » The Hogs went winless on the road against SA this year (0-3-0-1). It marks just the third time in 12 seasons the IceHogs have gone winless on the road in the series.
- » The home team is unbeaten through the first six games of the series and has now won 13 of the last 16 games in the series since 2016-17.

GAME NOTES

SUNDAY FUNDAY

The IceHogs enter Sunday's game unbeaten in regulation through seven Sunday games this season. Rockford is 6-0-0-1 on Sunday in 2018-19 with wins in each of the last five Sunday games. The team's lone defeat is a shootout loss vs. Manitoba on Oct. 28 (2-1 SOL).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOG IS

The Hogs are 16-5-1-1 at home against San Antonio since 2009-10, which marks the team's best winning percentage against any AHL opponent at home in that time:

KILLING OUR BUZZ

Rockford's penalty kill was ranked fourth in the league at 84.9 percent (25 PPG allowed in 166 attempts) entering Jan. 19. Since then, the Hogs have allowed at least one power-play goal in eight of the last 11 games, and multiple power-play goals in six of those contests. The IceHogs' PK unit has combined to go just 22-for-36 with 14 PPGs allowed over the last 11 games, and now ranks 18th in the league.

THE SCHREDDER

Jordan Schroeder notched his team-leading 30th and 31st points of the season with two goals against Iowa last night. Schroeder has now collected 30+ points in each of his last three AHL seasons in which he has skated in at least 30 games. In addition, his 13 goals this season are just one shy of matching his second-best goal total of his AHL career (2017-18 with Cleveland and 2015-16 with Iowa). The forward enters Sunday with points in eight of his last 10 games (4g, 5a) since Jan. 21.

POWER UP

Rockford extended its streak with a power-play goal to five straight games after finishing 1-for-5 with the man-advantage Saturday against Iowa. The five-game streak is tied for the team's season-best streak originally set from Oct. 6-20. The Hogs have totaled six PPGs during their current streak and are 6-for-26 (23.1%) on the PP in that span.

NILSSON RATINGS

Jacob Nilsson posted his third multi-point effort of the last four games with two helpers last night against the Wild. Nilsson has six points (2g, 4a) over the last four games and is now tied for the team lead with seven multi-point efforts on the season (He matched Dylan Sikura with his two-point game last night). In addition and including Saturday, the forward has tallied 10 of his last 11 points on home ice (6g, 4a at the BMO).

LOCKED AND LOADED

Rockford has scored 3+ goals in eight of the last 11 games dating to Jan. 19. The IceHogs are averaging 3.27 goals per game in that span with 36 tallies in 11 contests.

KING NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

» Derek King was named interim head coach on Nov. 6, 2018 and has led the IceHogs to a 18-18-2-3 (.500) record behind the bench. King replaced Jeremy Colliton, who piloted the Hogs to a record of 46-31-5-6 (.585) from 2017-18 prior to being named head coach of the Chicago Blackhawks.

CAMPBELL HITS AHL'S 700-GAME MILESTONE

» Defenseman Andrew Campbell became just the 74th player in the AHL's 82-year history to skate in 700 career AHL games on Feb. 9. He enters Sunday having skated in 702 AHL games during his 11-year career with Manchester, Portland, Toronto, Tucson and Rockford. He currently ranks:
