BACON BITS

LAST GAME:

» Anton Forsberg stopped 45 of 46 pucks and Luke Johnson netted the game-winner as the IceHogs downed the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins 2-1 at the BMO Harris Bank Center Wednesday. Josh McArdle scored his first AHL goal in the victory and has points in three of the last four games.

ICEHOGS VS. ROADRUNNERS SERIES NOTES

- » Rockford has points in each of its two contests against Tucson and scored 3+ goals in each game this season.
- » Tucson has scored the first goal in each game this year, but Rockford is outscoring the Roadrunners 4-0 in the third period.
- » The IceHogs have scored five of their eight total goals in the series while on the power play. Rockford tallied multiple power-play goals in the two games in Tucson, netting two on Oct. 19 and three PPGs on Oct. 20. Both Anthony Louis and Jordan Schroeder scored a PPG in each of the two games.

GAME NOTES

PACIFIC TO BE SPECIFIC

The IceHogs notched points in each of the first two games against Tucson this season and have points in 15 of 18 games against opponents from the Pacific Division since 2017-18. The Hogs are 12-3-2-1 against Pacific Division opponents in that time. Tucson is the lone team from the Pacific that Rockford will face this year.

ARIZONA ANDREW

IceHogs defenseman Andrew Campbell faces the Arizona Coyotes' AHL affiliate tonight after spending two seasons in the Arizona system during his NHL career. Campbell served as an alternate captain of the Portland Pirates in the Coyotes' system in 2014-15 and captained the Roadrunners in 2017-18. He combined to tally 18 points (5g, 13a) in 100 games between the two AHL teams, and logged an assist in 33 NHL contests with Arizona (2014-15).

LOCKED AND LOADED

Rockford has scored 3+ goals in five of the last seven games dating to Jan. 19. The IceHogs were last in the league with 2.24 goals/game prior to the current stretch, but are averaging 3.0 goals/game over the last seven contests (21 goals/7 games).

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The IceHogs notched just their third win of the season when scoring fewer than three goals with a 2-1 victory over the Penguins Wednesday. Rockford boasts a 19-1-1-1 clip when scoring at least three goals, but even with Wednesday's win, is just 3-18-2-4 when tallying fewer than three goals.

DIALED IN DYLAN

Dylan Sikura has points in five of the last six games with two goals and four assists since Jan. 21. Sikura has found the scoresheet in 21 of 38 games during his rookie year and leads the team with seven multi-point efforts. He also enters Friday ranked sixth among AHL rookies (more than 35 games) in points per game with his mark of 0.74 (28 points, 38 games).

DOWN THE STRETCH

The IceHogs have won a season-high five straight games and six of the last seven contests since Jan. 19. Rockford is now just one point in back of Milwaukee for fourth place/a potential playoff spot. Last year, Rockford went 14-5-1-1 over its final 21 games beginning Feb. 24 to reach the postseason.

NIGHTMARE ON ELM ST.

The IceHogs have won nine of the last 14 home games after snapping a franchise record-tying six-game home winless skid on Dec. 1. Rockford went 3-4-0-2 over its first nine home games of 2018-19, but has since posted a record of 9-4-1-0 at the BMO Harris Bank Center since Dec. 2.

BEST DEFENSE IS A GOOD...DEFENSE

The IceHogs held an opponent to two or fewer goals for the fourth straight game in a 2-1 win over Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Wednesday. Rockford has now limited opponents to two or fewer goals in more than half of its games this season, accomplishing the feat in 25 of 49 games in 2018-19. Overall, Rockford boasts the fourth-best scoring defense in the AHL with just 2.76 goals allowed per game.

KING NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

» Derek King was named interim head coach on Nov. 6, 2018 and has led the IceHogs to a 16-16-2-3 (.500) record behind the bench. King replaced Jeremy Colliton, who piloted the Hogs to a record of 46-31-5-6 (.585) from 2017-18 prior to being named head coach of the Chicago Blackhawks.

CAMPBELL APPROACHING AHL'S 700-GAME MILESTONE

» Defenseman Andrew Campbell is on pace to become just the 74th player in the AHL's 82-year history to skate in 700 career AHL games. He enters Friday having skated in 698 AHL games during his 11-year career with Manchester, Portland, Toronto, Tucson and Rockford. He currently ranks:
