### BACON BITS

#### LAST GAME:

» Kevin Lankinen made 24 saves and Jacob Nilsson notched a goal and an assist to lead the IceHogs to a 3-1 win over the Tucson Roadrunners Friday night at the BMO Harris Bank Center. Lankinen has won a season-high three straight games, while Rockford extended its streak to six games.

#### ICEHOGS VS. ROADRUNNERS SERIES NOTES

- » Rockford has points in each of its three contests against Tucson this year and has scored 3+ goals in each of the three games.
- » Rockford has scored six of its 11 total goals in the series while on the power play. Despite playing just three games against Tucson, the Hogs' six PPGs in the series are tied for the most against any team thus far this season. The only other team in which Rockford has six PPGs against is Chicago (The IceHogs have not scored more than four PPGs against any team aside from CHI and TUC).

#### GAME NOTES

##### PACIFIC TO BE SPECIFIC

The IceHogs are unbeaten in regulation against Tucson this season (2-0-1-0) and have points in 16 of 19 games against opponents from the Pacific Division since 2017-18. The Hogs are 13-3-2-1 against Pacific Division opponents in that time. Tucson is the lone team from the Pacific that Rockford will face this year.

##### MR. 700

IceHogs defenseman Andrew Campbell becomes just the 74th player in the AHL's 82-year history to skate in 700 career games when he takes the ice with Rockford tonight. He has skated with five AHL teams during his 11-year AHL career, reaching the impressive milestone tonight with games played for Manchester, Portland, Toronto, Tucson and Rockford. Campbell has served as captain or alternate captain for each of his five AHL teams and was also named the playing captain for the Western Conference at the 2019 AHL All-Star Classic. He is the first AHL player to hit the 700-game milestone this season, and first overall since Bracken Kearns, Tom Kostopoulos, Brett Sutter and Chris Bourque reached 700 games during the 2017-18 season.

##### CAMPBELL CLIMBING THE RANKS

Entering tonight's game, Andrew Campbell ranks 74th all-time in AHL history in games played, 28th in all-time games played by an AHL defenseman and 10th in career plus/minus rating with his +96 mark. With 25 games remaining in the 2018-19 regular season after tonight, Campbell can potentially conclude the year with 725 career AHL games.

##### LOCKED AND LOADED

Rockford has scored 3+ goals in six of the last eight games dating to Jan. 19. The IceHogs were last in the league with 2.24 goals/game prior to the current stretch, but are averaging 3.0 goals/game over the last eight contests (24 goals/8 games).

##### NIGHTMARE ON ELM ST.

Rockford has wins in 10 of the last 15 home games after snapping a franchise record-tying six-game home winless skid on Dec. 1. Rockford went 3-4-0-2 over its first nine home games of 2018-19, but has since posted a record of 10-4-1-0 at the BMO Harris Bank Center since Dec. 2.

##### BEST DEFENSE IS A GOOD...DEFENSE

The IceHogs held an opponent to two or fewer goals for the fifth straight game in a 3-1 win over Tucson Friday. Rockford has now limited opponents to two or fewer goals in more than half of its games this season, accomplishing the feat in 26 of 50 games in 2018-19. Overall, the Hogs are third in the league in scoring defense with just 2.72 goals against per game.

##### QUICK HITS

Jordan Schroeder tallied an assist and a point for the fourth straight game to extend his respective streaks to a season-high four games...The point streak is his longest since March 31 - April 6 of last year, and the four-game assist streak is his first since a five-gamer streak Nov. 22 - Dec. 2 in 2016-17...Dylan Sikura also extended his point streak to three games with an assist vs. Tucson... Sikura has now found the scoresheet in 22 of 39 games on the year...Jacob Nilsson posted his fifth multi-point effort of 2018-19 Friday...The IceHogs now boast four players with 5+ multi-point games this year.

##### KING NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

» Derek King was named interim head coach on Nov. 6, 2018 and has led the IceHogs to a 17-16-2-3 (.513) record behind the bench. King replaced Jeremy Colliton, who piloted the Hogs to a record of 46-31-5-6 (.585) from 2017-18 prior to being named head coach of the Chicago Blackhawks.

##### CAMPBELL HITS AHL'S 700-GAME MILESTONE

» Defenseman Andrew Campbell became just the 74th player in the AHL's 82-year history to skate in 700 career AHL games on Feb. 9. He enters Friday having skated in 699 AHL games during his 11-year career with Manchester, Portland, Toronto, Tucson and Rockford. He currently ranks:
