BACON BITS

MESSIN' WITH TEXAS: The IceHogs won three of four games against Texas during the 2017-18 regular season and enter tonight's game with victories in 13 of the last 18 games against the Stars since 2013-14...The IceHogs are 13-4-0-1 in the regular season against Texas in that span...In addition, Rockford went 2-0-0-0 at home against the Stars during the regular season in 2017-18 and boast a 7-2-0-0 clip at the BMO against Texas since 2013-14.

HEY, IT'S ME AGAIN: Rockford and Texas reached Game 6 of their playoff series last season before the Stars ultimately eliminated the IceHogs from the postseason...Four of the six games went into overtime and each of the six contests were decided by two or fewer goals.

SCORELESS SQUAD: Rockford and Texas enter tonight's game with both teams missing their top three scorers from the Western Conference Finals...The IceHogs no longer feature Chris DiDomenico (7 points vs. Texas), Cody Franson (5 points) or Adam Clendening (5 points), while the Stars are without Curtis McKenzie (7 points), Roope Hintz (6 points) and Jason Dickinson (5 points).

A STAR IS BORN: This year's home opener against the Texas Stars is exactly 11 years to the day of the IceHogs' first AHL victory, a 7-3 win over the original Texas Stars franchise, the Iowa Stars, on Oct. 13, 2007...Iowa was the affiliate of the Dallas Stars from 2005-08 and became the now-Texas Stars after moving to Austin in 2009.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: Rockford scored the first goal in each of its first two games, finding twine in the first period of both Friday and Saturday's contests...The Hogs now join Charlotte, Chicago, Iowa, San Jose and Texas as the league's only six teams to have scored the first goal in each of their first two games of the season...Rockford scored the first goal in 31 of 76 games last year (23-6-0-2 when scoring first in 2017-18).

HOT SHOTS: The IceHogs outshot Cleveland 25-22 in Friday's game and matched the Monsters with 31 shots on goal during Saturday's contest...Opponents have now managed to outshoot Rockford in just 18 of 78 games under second-year IceHogs head coach Jeremy Colliton...The Hogs, in turn, have outshot opponents in 52 of 78 games, and matched opponents in shots on goal in eight games under Colliton.

SIKURA SQUARED: The Sikura brothers, Tyler and Dylan, skated together for the first time in their professional careers during Friday's season-opening contest in Cleveland...The duo then hooked up on the power play during Saturday's game, with Dylan setting up Tyler for the IceHogs' first PPG of the 2018-19 season.
