### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs won the season opener against Texas on Oct. 13 and enter Friday with victories in 14 of the last 20 games against the Stars since 2013-14. Rockford is 14-5-0-1 during that span (regular season games). In addition, with a victory in the home opener of this year's series, the IceHogs boast an 8-2-0-0 clip at the BMO against Texas since 2013-14.

**OUT WITH A BANG:** Rockford and Texas have each scored 3+ unanswered goals in the third period in one of the games of this season's series. Rockford erupted for three goals in the third period at the BMO on Oct. 13, and the Stars scored four goals in the third period at the H-E-B Center on Nov. 16.

**USE THE FORS:** Anton Forsberg notched his first home win of 2018-19 with a season-high 41 saves on 43 shots on Dec. 7 vs. Grand Rapids. The 41 saves were the most for Forsberg in his last 17 AHL starts dating back to March 24, 2017 vs. Iowa (with Cleveland). Forsberg has now held opponents to two or fewer goals in seven of eight AHL games this season.

**POWER UP:** The IceHogs netted two power-play goals last night against Grand Rapids for just their third game with multiple PPGs this season. The effort was also the first multi-PPG game since Oct. 20 at Tucson. Rockford has now scored PPGs in two of the last three games, going 3-for-9 with the man-advantage over that span.

**ONE-AND-NOT-DONE:** The IceHogs have won three of their last four games, each by a one-goal margin in 3-2 OT victories. Rockford enters Saturday having notched each of their last six wins by just one goal, dating to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee.

**LUKEWARM:** Luke Johnson potted his first multi-goal game of the season and second of his AHL career with two tallies against the Griffins last night. He now leads the team in goals since returning from Chicago on Nov. 25 (three goals in six games).

**DOUBLE D(arren):** Darren Raddysh collected a pair of assists in Friday's win at the Griffins and now leads the team with five multi-point games this season. Raddysh is also currently Rockford's lone defenseman with more than one multi-point effort in 2018-19. The blueliner notched just one multi-point game in 66 contests during his AHL debut season last year.

**NIGHTMARE ON ELM STREET:** The IceHogs were shut out for the third time in just 12 games at home this season last Saturday against the Wolves. The three home shutouts are already the second-most in Rockford's AHL tenure, and trail only the five shutouts at the BMO during the 2009-10 season. Overall, the Hogs have scored one or no goals in six of their 12 home games in 2018-19.
