BACON BITS

LAST GAME:

» Anton Forsberg made 36 saves and Graham Knott netted the game-winner in overtime to send Rockford to a 3-2 win at Chicago Saturday. Forsberg made 30+ saves for the seventh time in 10 appearances. Rockford has won three of the last four OT games and is 7-3 overall in games decided in OT.

ICEHOGS VS. WILD SERIES NOTES

- » The IceHogs were shut out in three straight games by the Wild from Nov. 7 - Jan. 4 for the first time in franchise history.
- » Rockford responded with a season-high six goals in the last meeting, just two shy of its franchise-best mark against the Wild (8-3 win, Feb. 8, 2014). The six goals were the most scored against Iowa since a 7-1 win in last season's series opener on Oct. 14, 2017.
- » The Hogs currently average 3.43 more shots/game against Iowa than their overall total this season. Rockford is averaging 31.50 SH/G in the series.
- » Rockford is just 1-for-25 on the PP this season, last notching a PPG on Nov. 4. The IceHogs have been held to one or no PPGs in 16 of the last 17 meetings, with 13 games with no PPGs and three games with just one PPG. The lone multi-PPG game in that span is March 19 of last season (2-for-5).

GAME NOTES

TAMING THE WILD

Anthony Louis tallied his first AHL three-point game against the Wild on Jan. 6 and now boasts a point-per-game average over his last seven games against Iowa with four goals and three assists since April 10, 2018. He has produced two of his four multi-point games this season against the Wild.

QUICK ON THE TRIGGER

Rockford scored the first goal Saturday against Chicago and has now potted the first goal in three straight games. The three-game stretch is just the third time Rockford has scored the first goal in 3+ consecutive games this season, and is the first time since Nov. 20-25 (four games). Overall, Rockford's longest streak of scoring the first goal is four straight games (set Oct. 5-14 and matched Nov. 20-25).

LUCKY #7

The IceHogs snapped their season-high road winless streak at seven games with a win at Chicago. The streak finished tied with Providence, Ontario and Belleville for the longest overall road winless streak in the AHL thus far this season. Rockford went 0-5-1-1 on the road from Dec. 26 - Jan. 15.

WILL THE THRILL

William Pelletier notched an assist against the Wolves and now has points in four of the last five games. His current three-game point streak is just one shy of his career-high point streak from Jan. 7-13, 2018 (3g, 3a; included a hat trick on Jan. 10 at Ontario).

ON EDGE

Victor Ejdsell has tallied points in four of five games since returning to the lineup on Jan. 11. The forward currently boasts a season-high four-game point streak (2g, 2a) and has six points (2g, 4a) over his last eight contests dating to Dec. 14.

WE'RE OVER IT

The Hogs are currently tied for the most overtime games in the AHL following Saturday's win at Chicago. The Hogs have played into overtime in 15 of 44 games. Rockford is tied with Iowa and Milwaukee for the most OT games this season, putting each of the three teams with a league-high 15 OT games in the Central Division. Further, the IceHogs' seven OT wins are also tied for the most in the AHL as of Monday (also Charlotte).

HOT SOUP

Andrew Campbell tallied just one point (a goal) over his first 31 games this season but has since combined for three points (2g, 1a) over his last six games since Jan. 6. His three goals are the third-most of his 11-year AHL career behind only his six markers in 2016-17 and nine goals in 2015-16.

NOON GLOOM

The IceHogs enter today's noon game having dropped five straight contests with a noon-or-earlier start time (including going 0-3-0-0 this season). The last time the Hogs won a school-day/pre-12 p.m. game was during the 2016-17 season on Feb. 15, 2017 vs. Cleveland (2-0 win, 10:30 a.m. start).

KING NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

- » Derek King was named interim head coach on Nov. 6, 2018 and has led the IceHogs to a 11-15-2-3 (.435) record behind the bench. King replaced Jeremy Colliton, who piloted the Hogs to a record of 46-31-5-6 (.585) from 2017-18 prior to being named head coach of the Chicago Blackhawks.

CAMPBELL APPROACHING AHL'S 700-GAME MILESTONE

- » Defenseman Andrew Campbell is on pace to become just the 74th player in the AHL's 82-year history to skate in 700 career AHL games. He enters Monday having skated in 692 AHL games during his 11-year career with Manchester, Portland, Toronto, Tucson and Rockford. He currently ranks:
