BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs snapped a three-game win streak at Wells Fargo Arena with a loss in the most recent meeting in Iowa. Despite the loss, Rockford still boasts wins in 17 of its last 26 road games (17-8-1-0) against the Wild. Iowa has limited the IceHogs to one or no goals in three of four meetings this season after accomplishing the feat in just three of 12 total matchups during the 2017-18 campaign. Rockford, which is 26th in the league with 28.06 shots on goal per game, is averaging 34.0 shots on goal against the Wild through the first four meetings of the series.

BLANK SLATE: The IceHogs have been shut out in back-to-back games by the Wild for the first time in team history. Prior to this stretch, Rockford suffered just one shutout over the first 54 all-time meetings between the two teams. The IceHogs originally began the all-time series with six shutouts of Iowa and no shutouts in return, but the Wild have since flipped the trend to record each of the last three shutouts of the series since 2016-17.

HOG TIED: The IceHogs have allowed just two goals in three straight games and now rank fourth in the AHL with an average of just 2.83 goals/game. Rockford has held opponents to two or fewer goals in half of its 36 games entering Friday.

OFFENSIVE OFFENSE: In-turn with the above note, the IceHogs have scored one or no goals in 15 of 36 games as of Friday, and two or fewer goals in 22 of 36 contests. The Hogs are last in the league with an average of 2.22 goals per game, which is .16 fewer goals/game than the next-closest team in Manitoba (2.38 goals/game).

WILL THE THRILL: William Pelletier scored his first goal of the season during Wednesday's contest against the Griffins. Pelletier now has three points (1g, 2a) in seven games since making his season debut on Dec. 19, and is the 22nd IceHogs skater to score a goal through 35 games this season.

SIK 'EM: Tyler Sikura notched his 14th point of 2018-19 and finished with a +1 rating after picking up an assist on Pelletier's goal against Milwaukee. The reigning team MVP has skated in a team-high 118 games (including playoffs) since the beginning of the 2017-18 season, and his +27 rating in that span is +15 better than any other IceHogs forward (+7 than any Rockford skater: Viktor Svedberg, +20).

LOUI LOUI!: Anthony Louis has points in seven of his last 10 games after tallying an assist Wednesday against the Admirals. Louis led the team in scoring last season, and with his assist Wednesday, now shares the team lead with 21 points in 2018-19. The forward has combined for a team-high 73 points (23g, 50a) in 128 games with Rockford since making his team debut on March 17, 2017 (includes playoffs). His 73 points are 14 more than the second-best scorer in Matthew Highmore (59 points).
