### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs have been shut out in three straight games by the Iowa Wild for the first time in team history. Prior to this current stretch, Rockford suffered just one shutout by Iowa over the first 54 meetings between the two teams. The IceHogs began the all-time series with six shutouts of the Wild and no shutouts in return through the 2016-17 season, but Iowa has since flipped the trend to post each of the last four shutouts in the series (with no shutouts in return).

**A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE:** Rockford has been limited to one or no goals in four of the first five games in the 2018-19 series with Iowa, and allowed 3+ goals in each of the last three meetings between the teams. Overall, the IceHogs are being outscored 14-5 by the Wild entering Sunday's game.

**SKID MARKS:** The Hogs are currently on a season high-tying six-game winless streak dating back to Dec. 26. Rockford is 0-5-1-0 over that stretch, matching its previous skid of 0-4-0-2 from Nov. 14-25 this season. The six-game winless streak is tied for the longest active streak in the AHL (also Springfield), and is also the second-longest winless stretch overall for any team in the league in 2018-19. The last time Rockford went winless in more than six straight games was Feb. 25 - March 14 during the 2016-17 season (0-6-1-0).

**SUNDAY FUNDAY:** The IceHogs enter today's game unbeaten in regulation through six Sunday games this season. The Hogs have won each of their last four Sunday games dating back to a 4-2 win over Iowa on Nov. 4, and boast an overall record of 5-0-0-1 when playing on Sunday. Rockford's lone blemish on its record is a 2-1 shootout loss vs. Manitoba on Oct. 28.

**ANDREAS THE GIANT:** The Chicago Blackhawks reassigned forward Andreas Martinsen to the Hogs on Saturday. Martinsen won the IceHogs' Heavy Hitter Award last season, and paced the Blackhawks in hits this year with 83 in just 43 games. That total was 27 more than the next-closest player in Brent Seabrook, who recorded 56 hits while playing in nearly twice as many games as Martinsen.(43 games). Overall, Martinsen was tied for ninth in the entire NHL with 3.5 hits/game.

**DILLY, DILLY:** Chicago also reassigned forward Dylan Sikura to Rockford as part of Saturday's set of transactions. Sikura paced the IceHogs in scoring (18 points), goals (9) and shots on goal (90) prior to his promotion to the Blackhawks on Dec. 12. In addition, his four game-winning goals thus far this year still pace all AHL rookies, and also rank as the most GWG in a single season for a Hogs skater since the 2014-15 campaign (Mark McNeill, six GWG).

**LOCKED IN LANKINEN:** Kevin Lankinen has allowed just two goals in each of his last two appearances, stopping 41 of 43 shots on Dec. 29 at Chicago and 26 of 28 pucks on Dec. 31 at Grand Rapids. He takes the ice with a 1.98 GAA and .944 save percentage over his last two games.
