BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have notched points in eight of the last 12 meetings with the Wild dating to last season. Rockford is 7-4-1-0 against Iowa in that span and enters tonight's game with three consecutive victories in the series. At home, the IceHogs boast points in 19 of 26 all-time meetings at the BMO. The IceHogs have limited the Wild to two or fewer goals in six of the last nine games, and only once allowed more than three goals over that stretch (5-3 loss on Dec. 29, 2017 at Rockford).

DEUCE'S WILD: The IceHogs have held opponents to just two goals in each of the last four games. Prior to the beginning of this stretch, Rockford held opponents to two goals just once through the first six contests of the season (10/14/18 vs. HER, 5-2 win).

CENTRAL CASTING: Rockford is playing in the third contest of a stretch in which it plays 39 consecutive games against an opponent from the Central Division. The IceHogs will not face an opponent outside of the Central Division until Feb. 6, when they host the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins. The Hogs are 3-0-0-1 against foes from their own division in 2018-19, and have points in 13 of the last 16 games against the Central Division (11-3-1-1 record).

THRILLER NIGHT: The IceHogs claimed their first win in games beyond regulation and their first victory in one-goal games with a 3-2 OT win in Milwaukee last night. Rockford was 0-2 beyond regulation prior to the win, and entered Friday as one of only two teams in the AHL (also Grand Rapids) without a victory in one-goal games (0-1-1-1 in one-goal games prior to Friday).

COMEBACK KIDS: Rockford has already claimed two wins when trailing after two periods through the first 10 games of the season (seven wins all of last season), and also boast points in three of five games when trailing entering the final frame. The IceHogs are tied for the AHL lead in winning percentage when trailing after two periods (also Rochester, 3-3-0-0), and share second in total wins when trailing after two frames.

DOUBLE D(arren): Darren Raddysh posted his first two-goal game of his pro career last night with the game-tying and game-winning tallies. The defenseman logged just one multi-point game in 66 contests last season, and has already surpassed that total with three multi-point efforts through his first 10 games of the 2018-19 campaign. Raddysh shares the team lead with Dylan Sikura in multi-point games.

DYLAN DIALIN' IN: Dylan Sikura logged his third multi-point game with a goal and an assist last night. Sikura now boasts a point-per-game average over his last nine games with three goals and six assists in that span. He currently paces the team in scoring and enters Saturday first among AHL rookies in shots (35), tied for fourth in rookie PP assists (4) and tied for seventh in overall rookie scoring.
