### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs defeated Iowa 4-2 in their lone road game of the season's series on Nov. 4 and enter tonight's contest with wins in 17 of their last 25 games (17-7-1-0) at the Wells Fargo Arena. Rockford is also riding a three-game win streak on the road against the Wild and has scored 4+ goals in each of those last three contests (scored 14 total goals in that time).

**BLANK SLATE:** The Hogs were blanked by Iowa for just the second time in 55 all-time meetings in the teams' last game on Nov. 7. Rockford originally began the all-time series with six shutouts in the first three seasons against Iowa, before the Wild finally posted their first shutout of the Hogs in 2016-17.

**ALL HOT & BOTHERED:** The Hogs have won three straight games for the first time this season and enter Wednesday with a five-game point streak dating to Dec. 14 (4-0-1-0). Rockford's win streak is currently tied for the longest active streak in the AHL (also Hartford and Cleveland), and its five-game point streak is the second-longest behind Chicago (eight games). In addition, the IceHogs have won seven of 10 games (7-2-1-0) since snapping a season-long winless streak on Nov. 25.

**OVER-LOAD:** Rockford has played into overtime in back-to-back games and in six of its last eight contests overall since Dec. 2. Overall, the IceHogs have now reached overtime in more than a third of their games this season, with 12 of 31 total contests (38.7%) settled in OT or a shootout. Only Iowa (14) and Milwaukee (14) have more OT games than Rockford this season.

**ONE BY ONE:** The IceHogs have notched each of their last nine wins by a margin of just one goal dating back to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee. Rockford ranks fifth in the AHL in wins in one-goal games with a record of 10-2-2-4 in contests decided by a lone tally.

**THRU THE QUAD & INTO THE GYMNASIUM:** Anthony Louis extended his point streak to a team season-high six straight games with his assist against on Friday. Louis surpassed Tyler Sikura's five-game streak from October, and he enters Wednesday with six points (all assists) over his current streak.

**SO RAD:** Darren Raddysh has scored goals in back-to-back games, including netting the game-winner at Chicago on Friday. The defenseman has now scored seven goals and totaled 19 points through 31 games this season. His seven goals are tied for fifth among AHL defenseman, and his 19 points are just three shy of his total point production from 66 games last season.

**TRIPLE THREAT:** Alexandre Fortin (Dec. 14), William Pelletier (Dec. 19) and Jan Rutta (Dec.19) each joined the active lineup within the IceHogs' last five games and have all found the scoresheet in multiple contests during that short span. The trio has combined for 10 points (3g, 7a) through their combined 11 games with Rockford (Fortin-5 games, Pelletier-2 games, Rutta-4 games).
