BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have wins in 20 of the last 30 home games against Chicago (20-6-3-1 since 2013-14), and boast an overall home record of 41-17-3-1 (.693%) all-time against the Wolves. Last year's series featured three OT games at the BMO Harris Bank Center, and the two teams have now played into OT in four of the last seven meetings in Rockford since Feb. 7, 2016 (3 OT, 1 SO).

THIS ONE GOES TO 11: The IceHogs have scored at least one power-play goal in each of the last 11 games against the Wolves (includes playoffs), and have multiple PPGs in five straight meetings in the series. Rockford is 17-for-56 (30.4%) on the PP during its 11-game streak against Chicago.

ONE-MAN WOLFPACK: Anthony Louis led the IceHogs in scoring against Chicago last season (8 points) and picked up a point in the first game in this season's series on Nov. 10. Louis has now logged a point in nine his 12 career games against the Wolves, and combined for 10 total points (4g, 6a) against the team. He also enters tonight with a four-game point streak (2g, 3a) against Chicago.

KILLIN' THEM SOFTLY: The IceHogs return to the BMO boasting the AHL's third-best PK at home thus far this season at 92.3 percent. Rockford's PK unit has killed off each of the last 11 opposing power plays on home ice and 24 of 26 total power plays at the BMO in 2018-19. The Hogs' two PPGs allowed at home are currently tied for the fewest in the league (also Providence) as of Friday.

DIALED IN DYLAN: Dylan Sikura fired five shots on goal and logged his team-leading 14th point (goal) on Tuesday at San Antonio. Sikura currently shares fourth among AHL rookies in scoring and has yet to go more than two straight games this year without logging a point. His 68 shots on goal also rank second among all AHL skaters, and are 18 more than any other fellow rookie in the league.

LUKEWARM: Lucas Carlsson logged just two points in 11 games through Nov. 3, but has since combined for seven points in his last eight games since Nov. 4. Carlsson leads the team in scoring in that time with his one goal and six assists.

KIND OF A BIG DEAL..IA: Collin Delia recorded 30+ saves for the ninth time in 12 games this season with a 35-save effort Tuesday at San Antonio. Delia now leads the league in saves (401) and ranks third in both save percentage (.928) and minutes (731:33). He is averaging 33.4 saves per game this year, and his 401 total saves are 33 more than any other goalie in the league.

THE SHREDDER: Jordan Schroeder picked up his seventh point in 10 games this year with an assist on Tuesday at San Antonio. He has now combined for 33 points (15g, 18a) over his last 36 AHL games since Feb. 17 of last season (with Cleveland).
