BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The road team has won each of the first five games in the series with Rockford winning three contests in Rosemont and Chicago notching two victories in Rockford. Two of the IceHogs' top three goal scorers in the series are defenseman after both Darren Raddysh and Lucas Carlsson lit the lamp in the teams' most recent meeting on Dec. 21. Raddysh and Carlsson have combined for five goals against the Wolves this season. The Wolves have outshot Rockford in each of the five games in this season's series, combining for a 184-137 advantage in shots in goal entering Friday.

POWER TO THE PIGGIES: The IceHogs again scored a power-play goal against the Wolves in the teams' most recent meeting on Dec. 21 and have now tallied at least one PPG in 14 of the last 15 contests against Chicago. Rockford has combined for 20 PPGs over that span, going for 20-for-68 (29.4%) with the man-advantage. The lone game in which the Hogs were unable to score on the power play was during the 4-0 shutout on Dec. 8 in Rockford.

THE SCHREDDER: Jordan Schroeder has produced two of his three multi-point efforts on the season against the Wolves and enters tonight's contest as Rockford's leading scorer in the series with five points (5a) in four games. He has tallied points in 12 of his last 18 games against the Wolves with four multi-point efforts. Schroeder also paces all IceHogs skaters in career scoring against Chicago with 18 points (1g, 17a) in 25 career games.

ALL HOT & BOTHERED: The Hogs snapped a season-high three-game win streak with a shutout by Iowa on Wednesday. Despite the defeat, the IceHogs have notched points in seven of their last nine games since Dec. 2. Rockford is 6-2-1-0 over that span and has not suffered back-to-back losses since Nov. 23-24. In addition, the IceHogs enter Friday with points in three straight home games, which is tied for the team's longest such streak at the BMO during the 2018-19 season.

ONE BY ONE: The IceHogs have picked up each of their last nine wins by a margin of just one goal dating back to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee. Rockford ranks fourth in the AHL in wins in one-goal games with a record of 10-2-2-4 in contests decided by a lone tally.

THE REAL DEAL-IA: Former Rockford netminder Collin Delia earned his first NHL win streak with a victory in his second start with the Blackhawks last night vs. Minnesota. Delia, who appeared in 17 AHL games with Rockford to begin the season, made a career-high 46 saves last night and is now a combined 2-0-0 with a 1.50 GAA and .964 save percentage over his two contests with Chicago.

4 BY FOR(sberg): Anton Forsberg takes the ice tonight having led Rockford to points in each of his last four starts. The netminder is 3-0-1 over that span with 30+ saves in three of those four games. He boasts a 2.84 GAA and .925 save percentage during that span since Dec. 7.
