### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** Rockford has won two of the first three games against the Wolves this season but is seeking its first home win of the 2018-19 series. With two of three games decided by just one goal this season, 12 of the last 18 meetings have now been settled by a lone tally. That stretch includes eight of 12 games last season and two of the final three meetings of the 2016-17 campaign.

**LUCKY 13:** The IceHogs have scored at least one power-play goal in each of the last 13 games against the Wolves (includes playoffs), dating to Dec. 30 of last season. Rockford is 19-for-65 (29.2%) on the PP during that 13-game streak. The power play has accounted for 43 percent of the Hogs' scoring against the Wolves in that time, with Rockford netting 19 of its 44 goals on the power play. Eleven different IceHogs skaters have scored a power-play goal against Chicago during that stretch, including seven skaters with multiple PPGs.

**ONE-MAN WOLFPACK:** Anthony Louis led the IceHogs in scoring 4 against Chicago last season (8 points) and has found the scoresheet in each of his first three games of this season's series. Louis has logged a point in 11 of his 14 career games against the Wolves, and combined for 12 total points (5g, 7a) against the team. He also enters tonight with a six-game point streak (3g, 4a) against Chicago.

**CHUCKIN' DEUCES:** The IceHogs limited Grand Rapids to just two goals last night and have now held opponents to two or fewer goals in 13 of their first 25 games (52%) this season. In addition, Rockford has only once allowed more than three goals on home ice (7-2 loss vs. Chicago on Nov. 23). The Hogs enter Saturday ranked second in the league with just 26 goals allowed at home (2.4 goals/game), and sixth in the AHL with an average of just 2.84 goals allowed per game.

**STRAIGHT KILLAS:** Rockford has killed off each of the last 15 opposing power plays over the last five games (last power-play goal scored was by Chicago on Nov. 23). The Hogs have only once allowed more than one power-play goal in a game this season, and currently boast the second-best PK in the AHL with an efficiency of 87.5 percent. The IceHogs are also second in the AHL with a 92.3 efficiency on home ice with just three PPGs in 39 times shorthanded at the BMO.

**DYLAN'S DAGGERS:** Dylan Sikura has netted the game-winner in each of the last two games, potting the deciding tally against San Antonio and Grand Rapids. Sikura leads the team and paces all AHL rookies with four game-winning goals this season. His four GWGs through just 25 games are the most by an IceHogs skater in a single season since Mark McNeil's six GWGs in 2014-15.

**THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The IceHogs remained unbeaten in regulation when they score at least three goals following last night's 3-2 win over Grand Rapids. Rockford is 10-0-1-0 when scoring at least three goals, but is just 1-9-0-4 when scoring fewer than three goals in 2018-19.
