### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** Rockford posted the second-most wins against Grand Rapids in a single season in franchise history last year with a 6-3-1-0 mark against the club. That record trailed only a 7-0-0-1 clip in the series during the 2009-10 season. However, the IceHogs notched just one victory at Van Andel arena, going 1-3-1-0 in five road meetings. Rockford also enters today having allowed four or more goals in each of the last four games against the Griffins (all four games were at Van Andel).

**BEAST MASTER:** Anthony Louis enters today's contest with a nine-game point streak against the Griffins. Louis tallied at least one point in each of Rockford's nine games against Grand Rapids last season, including two multi-point efforts, and led the team in overall scoring in the series with 11 total points (2g, 9a). Louis's 11 points were the most for an IceHogs skater against any team in a single season since Vinnie Hinostroza's 14 points in 10 games against Milwaukee in 2015-16.

**OPENING ACT:** Rockford has won the series-opening game against the Griffins in each of the last nine seasons dating to the 2009-10 campaign. Overall, the IceHogs have won 10 of 11 series openers all-time against Grand Rapids since joining the AHL in 2007-08 (and have points in each of the 11 games; 10-0-0-1), with the lone exception a 6-5 shootout loss during the 2008-09 season.

**THIS ONE GOES TO 11:** Rockford has notched points in 11 of the last 13 games since Oct. 13. The IceHogs are 8-2-1-2 over that span to move into second place in the Central Division behind only Milwaukee.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The IceHogs have won a season-high five straight road games and boast points in a season-high six straight road games since Oct. 19 (5-0-1-0 in that span). The road win streak is just one shy of matching the team's longest such streak during the 2017-18 season (went 6-0-0-0 from 3/17-4/6).

**ONE-AND-NOT-DONE:** The IceHogs were the second-to-last team in the AHL to notch a win in one-goal games this season but have since won three of the last four contests decided by a lone tally. Rockford is 3-0-0-1 over its last four one-goal games after beginning the season 0-1-1-1 in such games.

**WAY RAD!:** Darren Raddysh has posted three points in his last two games to claim a share of the team lead in points thus far this season. His 12 points (4g, 8a) are tied with Dylan Sikura for first among Hogs skaters and rank sixth among all AHL defensemen.

**THE REAL DEAL-IA:** Collin Delia bounced back from just his second loss of the season Nov. 7 to make 37 wins in a victory against Chicago on Saturday. Delia now has just three regulation losses over his last 22 AHL regular-season games, and has not suffered back-to-back regulation losses in 32 games.
