BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs have won just one of the last six road games against the Rampage since the 2016-17 season, notching the lone victory on April 4, 2018 (4-2 win). Despite dropping Saturday's game 2-1, Rockford has held the Rampage to two goals in each of the last three meetings. The IceHogs have outscored San Antonio 10-6 over that span.

SAN AN STALEMATE: The IceHogs and Rampage have combined to kill off 16 of 18 power-play opportunities through two games in the 2018-19 series. Each team has killed off all but one of the opposition's PP chances in that span, with Rockford's PK going 6-for-7 and San Antonio at 10-for-11.

HOME ON THE RANGE: With Rockford winning its lone home game in the series against San Antonio this season and the Rampage winning Saturday's contest at AT&T Center, the home team has now won nine of the last 11 games in the series. Rockford is 4-1-0-0 at home in that span, while San Antonio is 5-1-0-0 at home during that stretch.

STRAIGHT KILLAS: Rockford has only once allowed more than one PPG in a game in 2018-19 (Oct. 19 at TUC, 2 PPGs). The Hogs enter Tuesday boasting the fourth-best PK in the AHL at 86.1 percent, and have allowed the eighth-fewest power-play goals (11) in the league.

BEST DEFENSE IS A GOOD OFFENSE: Carl Dahlstrom scored the first goal by a Rockford defenseman in eight games with his tally against San Antonio (first goal for D-man since Nov. 2 at MIL). Overall, five different defenseman have now scored for Rockford this season, which ranks just two shy of Belleville's league-high seven blueliners with goals in 2018-19. Only six AHL teams boast more defensemen with 1+ goals this year: BEL-7, BRI-6, CHA-6, TOR-6, TEX-6 and ONT-6.

A LITTLE OFFENSIVE: Rockford has scored just one goal in each of its last three games since Nov. 14, and has been held to one or no goals in eight of 18 total games during the 2018-19 season. Rockford enters the week ranked 30th out of 31 teams in overall scoring (2.50 goals/game) behind only San Antonio (2.12 goals/game).

SECOND IS THE BEST: The IceHogs potted a goal during the second period Saturday at San Antonio and boast a +5 scoring advantage in the middle frame. Rockford's +5 edge is the best of any period this season, trumping its first-period mark of -8 and third-period tie of 15 goals scored and allowed.

AWW, SHOOT: The IceHogs fired a season-low 15 shots on goal during Saturday's game. The effort was Rockford's fewest shots on goal in 160 games, dating back to the 10th game of the 2016-17 season when the IceHogs totaled 14 SOG on Nov. 3, 2016 at Charlotte.
