BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The IceHogs won the season opener against Texas on Oct. 13 and enter Friday with victories in 14 of the last 19 games against the Stars since 2013-14. Rockford is 14-4-0-1 during the regular season against Texas in that span. In addition, the Hogs have wins in eight of the last 11 road games in the series with a 8-2-0-1 clip at the H-E-B Center since the beginning of 2012-13.

TRIPLE-THREAT NET: Netminder Collin Delia remained unbeaten against the Texas Stars through three career regular-season starts against the team with 34 saves on Oct. 13. Delia is 3-0-0 with a 1.96 GAA and .940 save percentage over those last three appearances against the Stars.

THIS ONE GOES TO 11: Rockford has notched points in 11 of the last 14 games since Oct. 13. The IceHogs are 8-3-1-2 over that span to move into second place in the Central Division behind only Milwaukee.

STREAK SNAPPED: The IceHogs snapped both a season-high road win and point streak with Wednesday's loss at Grand Rapids. Rockford won five straight road games prior to the loss, and matched its longest road point streak of 2017-18 with points in six straight road games (5-0-1-0) in that stretch.

FIRST IS THE WORST: Rockford allowed the first goal during the first period Wednesday and is now being outscored 9-16 in the first period this season. The IceHogs have allowed the first goal in half of their 16 games on the year, and their -7 goal differential in that frame is the lowest of any period.

STRAIGHT KILLAS: The IceHogs have yet to allow a power-play goal in more than two consecutive games this season, and their penalty-kill unit has only once allowed more than one PPG in a game in 2018-19 (Oct. 19 at TUC, 2 PPGs). Rockford enters Friday with the fifth-best PK in the AHL at 87.3%, and tied for the seventh-fewest PPGs allowed (9) this season.

NILSSON RATINGS: Jacob Nilsson notched his second goal and sixth point of the season during Wednesday's game at Grand Rapids. The rookie forward has now posted five (2g, 3a) of his six points during road games (lone point at home was an assist on Oct. 13 vs. Texas).

LUKE FIVE-WALKER: Lucas Carlsson has five points in his last five games with one goal and four assists over that span. He logged just two points through his first 11 contests of the season prior to his current five-game stretch. Carlsson also enters Friday riding a season-high three-game point streak.

SHOOT YOUR SHOT: Dylan Sikura has fired multiple shots on goal in 14 of his first 16 AHL games. The rookie enters Friday ranked first among all AHL skaters with 59 shots on goal. His 59 shots are three more than any AHL skater and 17 more than any fellow rookie in the league.
