GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The IceHogs defeated the Rampage in the first game at the BMO Harris Bank Center this season and now boast points in 17 of the last 22 home games against San Antonio since the 2009-10 season. The Hogs are 15-5-1-1 at home against the Rampage in that time, which marks Rockford's best winning percentage against any AHL opponent at home since the 2009-10 season.
- **KILLING THEM SOFTLY:** The IceHogs have killed off each of the last 11 opposing power plays over the last three games. Rockford is tied for fourth in the AHL with an 86.7 efficiency on the PK, and have only once allowed more than one power-play goal in a game. The Hogs also enter Sunday ranked third in the AHL with a 90.9 PK efficiency on home ice, having allowed just three total power-play goals in 33 times shorthanded at the BMO.
- **ANT MAN & THE HOGS:** Anthony Louis has tallied points in each of his three games against the Rampage this season and enters Sunday with a four-game point streak against San Antonio dating to April 4, 2018. Louis has four points (1g, 3a) during that streak.
- **USE THE FORS:** Anton Forsberg allowed just two goals against Milwaukee last night and has now limited opponents to two or fewer goals in six of his first seven AHL appearances this season. Forsberg is unbeaten on the road for the IceHogs, going 4-0-0 away from the BMO, but enters Sunday seeking his first home win of the campaign.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The IceHogs host the Rampage and the first 1,500 through the doors will receive a free IceHogs winter hat today, courtesy of BMO Harris Bank.
