GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** Rockford posted the second-most wins against Grand Rapids in a single season in franchise history last year with a 6-3-1-0 mark against the club. That record trailed only a 7-0-0-1 clip in the series during the 2009-10 season. Three of five home games against Grand Rapids went to the shootout last season, with the IceHogs winning each of the three games while holding the Griffins to 0-for-10 in shootout attempts.
- **NOT-SO-GRAND RAPIDS:** The IceHogs went unbeaten in their five home games against Grand Rapids in 2017-18, marking the most home victories in a single season against the Griffins. The IceHogs have now won six straight home games against Grand Rapids dating to the final meeting of the 2016-17 season. Rockford has outscored the Griffins 24-12 at home in that span.
- **CHUCKIN' DEUCES:** The IceHogs have limited opponents to two or fewer goals in half of their first 24 games this season. In addition, Rockford has allowed more than three goals in only five games on the year, and only once at the BMO.
- **CAPTAIN CLUTCH:** Dylan Sikura netted the game-winner in overtime during Rockford's most recent game against San Antonio. Sikura now leads the team and paces all AHL rookies with three game-winning goals this season. In addition, his three GWGs through 24 contests also match last year's team-leading total (four skaters), and are more than any skater during the 2016-17 season.
- **TODAY'S PROMOTION:** The IceHogs host the Grand Rapids Griffins and the first 1,000 fans through the doors will receive a free IceHogs cooler bag, courtesy of Bud Light.

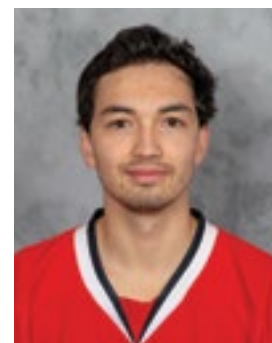

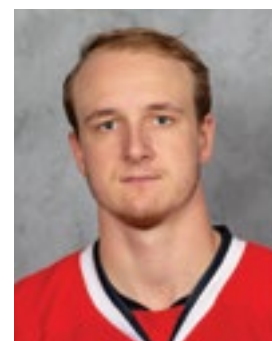

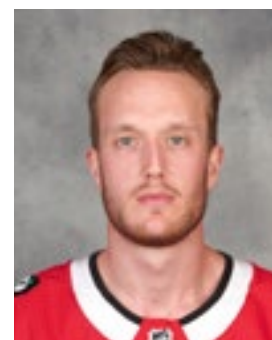
