GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs have won three straight games against the Griffins and have points in 10 of the last 14 meetings in the series since the final game of 2016-17 (9-4-1-0 in that span). With a Rockford win at the BMO Harris Bank Center in the most recent game of the series, the home team (in general wins and losses) has posted a 49-20 record since the beginning of the 2010-11 season.
- **VAN-ANDALIZING THE GRIFFINS:** Jordan Schroeder has 11 points over his last eight games at Van Andel Arena, logging three goals and eight assists in that span. Overall, Schroeder enters Monday with 22 total points (9g, 13a) in 31 career games against the Griffins.
- **SAVE THE DATE:** Darren Raddysh enters the final game of 2018 with the fourth-most points by a defenseman at the turn of the New Year in team history (AHL affiliation). His 21 points prior to Jan. 1 trail only Adam Clendening in 2013-14 (23 points), T.J. Brennan in 2014-15 (28 points) and Brian Connelly in 2011-12 (29 points). Additionally, Raddysh has already tied the team record for most goals by a defenseman before the New Year (also Cameron Schilling and Brennan).
- **THE SCHREDDER:** Jordan Schroeder logged an assist Saturday at Chicago and now has seven points (3g, 4a) over his last eight games since Dec. 14. The forward has also fired a shot on goal in 24 of 25 contests this year and his 2.9 shots on goal/game are nearly a full shot better than any current IceHogs skater.
- **LOCKED IN LANKINEN:** Rookie netminder Kevin Lankinen set a franchise record (AHL) for most saves in a single period with 25 stops on 26 shots in the first period Saturday against Chicago. Lankinen surpassed Alec Richards' previous record of 21 saves set on Nov. 18, 2011.

The Grand Rapids Griffins enter Monday's contest with points in four straight games (3-0-1-0) and a 7-1-1-1 clip over their last 10 contests at Van Andel Arena. Grand Rapids has suffered just three regulation losses in 17 games on its home ice this season, which is good for the fourth-best home record (11-3-1-2) among all AHL teams. Only Bridgeport and San Antonio have more wins at home.
