GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** Rockford has won each of the first two home games of the series and have points in 18 of the last 23 home games against SA. The home team is unbeaten through the first six games of the series and has won 13 of the last 16 games in the series since 2016-17.
- **SUNDAY FUNDAY:** The IceHogs enter Sunday's game unbeaten in regulation through seven Sunday games this season. Rockford is 6-0-0-1 on Sunday in 2018-19 with wins in each of the last five Sunday games.
- **HOME IS WHERE THE HOG IS:** The Hogs are 16-5-1-1 at home against San Antonio since 2009-10, which marks the team's best winning percentage against any AHL opponent at home in that time:
 1. SA (.739) | 2. CLE (.707) | 3. GR (.692) | 4. CHI (.654)
- **POWER UP:** Rockford extended its streak with a power-play goal to five straight games after finishing 1-for-5 with the man-advantage Saturday against Iowa. The five-game streak is tied for the team's season-best streak originally set from Oct. 6-20.
- **LOCKED AND LOADED:** Rockford has scored 3+ goals in eight of the last 11 games dating to Jan. 19. The IceHogs are averaging 3.27 goals per game in that span with 36 tallies in 11 contests.
- **TONIGHT'S PROMOTION:** Sunday is Discovery Center Night and the Discovery Center will be on-hand to provide demonstrations throughout the IceHogs game. In addition, the first 2,500 fans in attendance for the Hogs and Rampage will receive a free 20th anniversary IceHogs poster, courtesy of Hub Printing. Tonight is also the final post-game Skate with the Hogs of the 2018-19 season.
