## GAME NOTES

- **SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs have won two of three all-time games against WBS and take the ice tonight with a two-game win streak in the series. Rockford has held WBS to just one total goal in the last two meetings with a shutout in the 2017-18 finale and a 2-1 win in this season's opener.
- **HOT HOGS:** The IceHogs extended their point streak to four straight games with a shootout loss at Hershey last night, and now have points in 10 of the last 12 contests since Jan. 25 (9-2-0-1). That 12-game stretch has boosted the Hogs from last in the Central Division on Jan. 25 to fourth place with a three-point cushion over Texas entering Sunday
- **TO THE POWER OF 7:** With a power-play goal from Peter Holland last night, Rockford has now scored a PPG in seven of the last eight games since Feb. 6. The power-play unit is 8-for-37 (21.6%) with the man-advantage over that time. Prior to this stretch, the IceHogs PP unit needed 21 game from Dec. 15 - Feb. 2 to score eight power-play goals.
- **THE SCHREDDER:** Jordan Schroeder has 13 points (6g, 7a) over his last 13 games to boost his season's scoring total to 35 on the year (15g, 20a). His solid season marks just the second time of his 10-year AHL career he has reached both 15+ goals and 20+ assists.
- **SAVE SQUAD:** The IceHogs boast the best save percentage of any AHL team entering Sunday with a mark of .918. That total is seven points better than any other AHL club. Anton Forsberg paces the IceHogs' goaltending corps and currently ranks second among all qualified AHL netminders with his save percentage of .921.

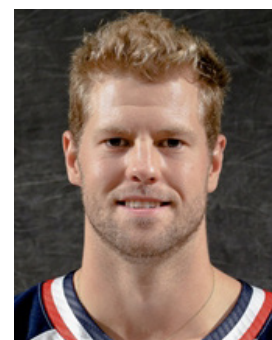
