GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The IceHogs travel to the Tucson Convention Center for their second of four total matchups against the Tucson Roadrunners. Rockford erased a three-goal deficit to force overtime Friday but ultimately suffered a 4-3 OTL against tonight's opponent.
- **PACIFIC TO BE SPECIFIC:** Rockford faces a Pacific Division foe for the second time of the 2018-19 season. The IceHogs have notched points in 14 of 17 games against opponents from the Pacific Division since 2017-18, going 11-3-2-1 against such opponents in that span.
- **TYLER'S TRAVELS:** Tyler Sikura has notched two of his first three goals in road games thus far this season. Sikura led the team and set Rockford's franchise record with 18 total tallies in road games last year. Last year's team MVP combined for 28 points (of his 39 total points) on the road during the 2017-18 campaign.
- **HERE'S THE DELIA:** Collin Delia has bounced back from his lone loss of the season to win each of his last two AHL starts. Delia now boasts a record of 12-2-2 over his last 16 regular-season games with Rockford dating to Feb. 18 of the 2017-18 campaign. The netminder has made 26 consecutive appearances since last suffering back-to-back losses (last back-to-back losses: Jan. 2 & 5).
- **POWER UP:** With a pair of power-play goals against Tucson, the IceHogs extended their streak to four straight games with at least one PPG (five total PPG in that span). Anthony Louis, Jordan Schroeder (two) and Tyler Sikura (two) have combined for power-play markers during Rockford's current streak.
