GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The IceHogs host the San Antonio Rampage for the first of eight games in the season series. Rockford split the 2017-18 matchup with San Antonio, going 3-2-0-1, and enters tonight's contest with a three-game winning streak against the team. Forward Matthew Highmore led the Hogs with five points (2g, 3a) in six games against San Antonio last year.
- **BULL BY THE HORNS:** Rockford boasts points in 16 of the last 21 home games against San Antonio since the 2009-10 season. The IceHogs are 14-5-1-1 at home against the Rampage in that time, which marks Rockford's best winning percentage (.714) against any AHL opponent at home during that time.
- **TRIPLE THREAT:** Carl Dahlstrom logged the first three-point game for an IceHogs skater this season with his trio of assists against Tucson on Saturday. The effort was Dahlstrom's first three-assist game of his AHL career and just his second overall three-point game during his AHL tenure.
- **CAPTAIN CLUTCH:** Rockford has both scored a goal and held opponents scoreless in the third period during each of the last five games... The IceHogs have combined to outscore opponents 10-0 in the third period over those last five games (since Oct. 6).
- **POWER UP:** The IceHogs scored five power-play goals during their two-game series with the Roadrunners last weekend. The effort gives Rockford power-play goals in five consecutive games and eight total power-play goals this season. The Hogs currently rank tied for fourth among all AHL teams in total power-play goals.

San Antonio has been outscored 22-9 during their six-game losing streak, only twice scoring more than one goal during that stretch dating to Oct. 9
