GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The IceHogs host Iowa for the first matchup of their 2018-19 series with the Wild. The IceHogs have notched points in eight of their last 12 meetings with the Wild dating to last season. Rockford is 7-4-1-0 against Iowa in that span and enters tonight's game with three consecutive victories in the series. At home, the IceHogs boast points in 19 of 26 all-time meetings at the BMO.
- **DEUCE'S WILD:** The IceHogs have held opponents to just two goals in each of the last four games. Prior to the beginning of this stretch, Rockford held opponents to two goals just once through the first six contests of the season (10/14/18 vs. HER, 5-2 win).
- **COMEBACK KIDS:** Rockford has already claimed two wins when trailing after two periods through the first 10 games of the season (seven wins all of last season), and also boast points in three of five games when trailing entering the final frame.
- **DOUBLE D(arren):** Darren Raddysh posted his first two-goal game of his pro career last night with the game-tying and game-winning tallies. The defenseman logged just one multi-point game in 66 contests last season, and has already surpassed that total with three multi-point efforts through his first 10 games of the 2018-19 campaign. Raddysh shares the team lead with Dylan Sikura in multi-point games.
- **TONIGHT'S PROMOTION:** Tonight is Military Appreciation Night at the BMO Harris Bank Center. All active and former military members will receive a free ticket to the game with valid ID, and the first 2,500 fans in attendance will receive a free camo IceHogs baseball hat, courtesy of Rose Pest Solutions.

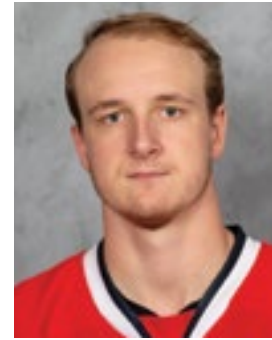

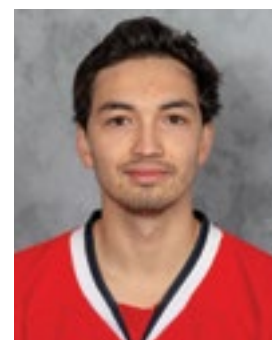
