GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** The IceHogs travel to Iowa for the second matchup of the 2018-19 series with the Wild. The IceHogs snapped a three-game win streak against Iowa with last night's loss at the BMO Harris Bank Center. Rockford has limited Iowa to two or fewer goals in seven of the last 10 games dating to Dec. 29, 2017.
- **DEUCE'S WILD:** The IceHogs have held opponents to just two goals in each of the last five games. Prior to the beginning of this stretch, Rockford held opponents to two goals just once through the first six contests of the season (10/14/18 vs. HER, 5-2 win).
- **CENTRAL CASTING:** Rockford is playing in the fourth contest of a stretch in which it plays 39 consecutive games against an opponent from the Central Division. The IceHogs will not face an opponent outside of the Central Division until Feb. 6, when they host the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins. The Hogs are 3-0-0-2 against foes from their own division in 2018-19, and have points in 14 of the last 17 games against the Central Division (11-3-1-2 record).
- **WE'RE SO EXTRA:** The IceHogs have played beyond regulation in three straight games with one contest settled in overtime and two shootouts. Dating back to Oct. 19, four of the last seven games have extended into overtime, and the four total overtime games rank tied for the second-most for any team in the AHL behind only Milwaukee.
- **THE REAL DEAL-IA:** Netminder Collin Delia made a season-high 41 saves while helping Rockford reach overtime last night. The 41 saves were the second-highest total of his career behind only 46 stops on Feb. 2 vs. Manitoba last season. Delia currently leads all AHL goalies with 237 saves in seven games.



The Iowa Wild enter Sunday's game ranked third in the Central Division and have won each of their last four games. The Wild are second in the league with 4.22 goals per game and are led offensively by forwards Cal O'Reilly and Mason Shaw, who share the team lead in points with two goals and six assists apiece. Iowa also paces all AHL teams with a 33.3 power-play efficiency percentage.
