## GAME NOTES

- **TODAY'S MATCHUP:** Rockford and Chicago have a perfect split of their 124 regular-season meetings with each of the two teams posting a 62-62 record in the series. The IceHogs and Wolves face off for the first time since the IceHogs swept the Wolves in the first round of the 2018 Calder Cup playoffs. Rockford finished the three-game series 7-for-18 (39.0%) on the power play, and totaled 16 PPGs in 15 games in the overall series (both regular and postseason).
- **FIRST & 5:** The IceHogs have won the series-opening game against the Wolves in each of the last five seasons dating to the 2013-14 season. Four of those five games have been decided by just one goal, and two of the five have extended into a shootout.
- **THE WOLF OF DAHL-STREET:** Carl Dahlstrom finished tied for the lead on the IceHogs in scoring against the Wolves last season with eight points (8a) in 12 games. He has totaled 10 points during his AHL career against Chicago, which rank as Dahlstrom's highest point total against any AHL opponent.
- **ROAD WARRIORS:** Rockford extended its season-high road point streak to each of its last five games with a win at Milwaukee. The IceHogs opened the season with back-to-back road losses at Cleveland but have since gone 4-0-1-0 over their last five road games since Oct 19 (includes four straight wins).
- **(FIF)TEEN WOLF:** Terry Broadhurst has logged 15 points (6g, 9a) in his last 19 games against the Chicago Wolves dating to the beginning of the 2013-14 season. He has skated with the IceHogs during each of those contests, and notched points in 11 of the 19 games.

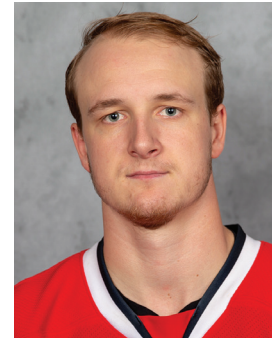
